PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

Parent and guardian behavior at youth sports games and practices have a significant impact on player experience. Parents/guardians are expected to set an example for young players by displaying the same high-level of sportsmanship expected of all participants and respecting all players, coaches, officials, and volunteers.

I WILL:

- Remember that children participate to have fun.
- Be a positive role model and encourage sportsmanship.
- Teach my child to play by the rules and resolve conflict without resorting to hostility or violence.
- Insist that my child treat coaches, officials, and other players with respect, regardless of race, creed, color, sex, or ability.
- Teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning.
- Praise my child for competing fairly and trying their best.
- Promote the emotional and physical well-being of athletes above my personal desire to win.
- Respect officials and their authority during games.

I WILL NOT:

- Force my child to participate.
- Engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with officials, coaches, players, and other spectators, including booing, taunting, using profanity, refusing to shake hands, etc.
- Ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a game.
- Possess or use firearms, alcohol, or drugs at TPCG Athletics & Leisure league events.
- Coach my child or other players during games and practices unless I am an official Athletics & Leisure coach.

I understand that a breach of this policy will result in ejection from the facility and possible suspension from any TPCG Quality of Life Athletics & Leisure events for a minimum of one year.

Failure to leave the premises peacefully upon ejection will be handled by law enforcement.
